"Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord in gladness; come into his presence with singing." –Psalm 100:1-2

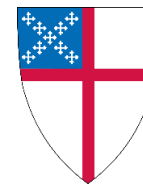

Traveling from Traverse City (about 25 miles) or Leland (about 11 miles), follow M-22 north until you reach the blinking light inside Northport's village limits. From the light, follow M-201 north through the village of Northport until you reach 7th Street. Turn left on 7th Street and proceed two blocks to Warren Street, where you will see St. Christopher's/St. Gertrude's Church building.
